## Photography Challenge: Composition

Take a photo that shows your understanding of each composition concept

Rule of Thirds	Imagine a 3x3 grid. Position the most important elements in your scene along one of these lines, or at the intersection points of these lines.	
Fill the Frame	Sometimes, the main subject gets lost in the clutter of its surroundings. Fill the frame, cropping in tight around the subject to eliminate background distractions	
Leading Lines	Compose your shot so that the lines in the image draw the viewer into the photograph. The lines could be straight, curved, wavy, jagged, etc.	
Viewpoint	Before you take a photo, think about where you will shoot it from. If you change your viewpoint (e.g. from down low, from up above, from behind, on an angle, etc.), will it make your photo more engaging/interesting?	
Negative Space	Bring attention to your subject by placing it in front of a simple, plain background.	
Symmetry and Patterns	Take a photo of a pattern or symmetry that you notice in the world around you.
